Minutes of the Meeting of Steering Committee for 'Quadrupling GDP of Meerut'

The meeting commenced with Shri Dinesh Singhal representing host MCF welcoming Shri Rajendra Agrawal, Hon'ble Member of Parliament and requesting him to Chair the meeting. Shri Agrawal having assumed chair welcomed all participant

Agenda point 1: Opening Remarks

Addressing the first meeting of the Steering Committee after release of the study by Hon'ble Union Minister of Finance for State Shri Pankaj Chaudhari on Dec 2nd, 2023, Chairman informed that the study was presented to Hon'ble PM who appreciated the fact that the study was done by people of Meerut. He even remarked that this was how the GDP growth plan should be made. PMO later requested 30 copies and took note of the action plan prepared for execution. He reminded the Committee members that the study generated a lot of interest in political and economic circles and there was heightened responsibility of the Committee to excel in execution also to meet the expectations.

Agenda Point 2: Review of Steering Committee Terms of Reference & composition

A note on Terms of Reference of the Steering Committee was presented which described Objective, Composition of the Committee, Role, Working Groups and mandate for Stakeholder engagement. The ToRs were approved.

Agenda Point 3: Action Plan

A draft plan of action to implement the recommendations of the study for 'Quadrupling GDP of Meerut' was presented to the Committee. The committee took note of the following:

i. The State Govt. was already pushing for investment mobilization and ground of various infrastructure projects in Meerut.

Need for coordination stressed

ii. In context of improving participation of women in work force, a working women hostel was being built in industrial area of Meerut by Nagar Nigam.

Provision for expansion of facility suggested

- iii. On relocation of labour from Agri to high skilled job two steps were discussed:
 - a. Apprenticeship: The number of apprenticeship opportunities for Govt depts/ private industries to be identified and encouraged
 - Skill Development: Meetings with industry & clusters to identify the skills required by them.

iv. Institutional Reform: With regards to Committee was apprised that most of the issues raised in study were already in consideration and 8 zonal plans out 15 would definitely be completed upto Aug 2024. Further, MDA was working on 'Form based planning' to pave way for many structures in old settlements to be regularised. For reducing delays, MDA was in process of digitizing most of its services. About the delays in road projects due to land acquisition, 'Town Planning Scheme' model of Gujarat could be emulated. Because small discretionary additions in industries- even within 10% of approved area, could not be allowed under the prevailing regulations, amendment in byelaws was suggested. v. Strengthening of clusters: It was proposed to identify their requirements of clusters, meetings with each cluster to be done separately on priority.

Noted. Immediate meeting with clusters to be planned.
